

## <u>Memo</u>

This is a clarification of the MOU between Browning Public Schools and Tribal Health who have developed and approved a budget that will ensure successful implementation of sports summer camps.

- Personnel Costs: compensation to bring in camp coordinators, coaches, trainers and support staff at the professional and collegiate level.
- Facility Use: Coverage for facility maintenance, utilities, and operational costs during camp dates and to secure those dates.
- **Training Supplies:** Funding for sports gear, safety equipment, and program materials.
- **Health & Safety:** On-site supplies such as med-kits, hydration, and safety measures towards virus protection.

Tribal Health will contribute not only financial resources but also personnel and health services, ensuring the camps maintain a holistic approach to physical and mental wellness. BPS will oversee administrative coordination, camp logistics, and staff recruitment.

The summer youth sports camps will provide a structured, enriching environment for students who may otherwise lack access to physical activity and social engagement during summer months. More importantly, this budget plan allows us to seamlessly continue essential programming that has been implemented since 2012.

We are confident that this partnership will serve as a strong foundation for future collaboration and set a model for community based educational and wellness programming.
