I would like to develop and submit a grant to the Four Way Foundation on behalf of the College and Career Centers at IVHS and HVHS. HVHS is requesting 4 HP ProDesk 400GZ computers and 4 electrical drops totally \$2500. IVHS is requesting 2 foldable tables, 8 folding chairs, 4 bean bag chairs, 4 lapdesks, and a color printer for a total of \$1290. The full grant request will be for \$3790.

Provide history/background information on your proposal:

The College and Career Centers are flourishing with the hiring of the positions of College and Career Advocates. HVHS has a high need for additional computers to support student work, particularly during peak times of college applications and scholarship completion. IVHS needs folding tables/chairs that can be used for group work and then stored away when not needed as the floor space is limited. The bean bags and the lapdesks will help create a welcoming environment where students can utilize different equipment to complete their work. The color printer will be used by College and Career Center staff to enhance additional grant materials and to create flyers to advertise events.
