**SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF CITY OF FORT WORTH TEMPORARY RIGHT OF ENTRY AND RIGHT OF WAY EASEMENT ON GOLDEN TRIANGLE BOULEVARD**

**BOARD GOAL: Keller Independent School District facilities and services will be operated in a safe manner so that all students and employees may thrive in a secure and nurturing environment.**

**FISCAL NOTE: Bond Funds**

**Background Information:**

- The City of Fort Worth is preparing to rebuild Golden Triangle Boulevard. A Temporary Right-of-Entry and Right of Way Easement will be required. It gives right-of-entry to the work areas for the purpose of constructing, maintaining and operating a public street, and its appurtenances.
- The right of way easement is a permanent easement.

**Administrative Considerations:**

- By approving this Temporary Right of Entry and Right of way Easement, the development of a better, safer road on Golden Triangle Boulevard will be ensured.
- The district's legal counsel has reviewed the document.

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**The administration recommends the Board of Trustees approve the temporary right of entry and right-of-way easement as presented.**
