

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Our school receives federal funds for Title One programs that are part of the **No Child Left Behind Act**. - The type of college degree major of the teacher and the field of discipline for any graduate degrees and certificates

### EDUCATION OF ALL DISABLED CHILDREN/YOUNG ADULTS

Public Law 105.17 known as I.D.E.A. (Individualized Disability Education Act) requires that school districts provide a free and appropriate education to all disabled children/young adults ages 0 to 21.
