Community Education



Mahtomedi provides \$60,000 in annual support

The amount was determined years ago allegedly based on community education participation rates for Mahtomedi residents

The contribution goes toward

- \$12,000 to District Education Center (DEC) rink site costs
- \$16,500 senior program support
- \$ 1,000 community event support
- \$23,176 summer recreation/facility use
- \$(7,234) reduction based upon city park use of facilities




DEC Rinks

Collaboration between city, district, and Mahtomedi Youth Hockey Association (MYHA)

- City: owns warming house, helps pay site costs, flails and trims around rinks, made the new gate and signage
- District: owns rinks and storage shed, manages rink agreement, pays rink manager, puts woodchips on trail, provided an AED
- MYHA: Helps pay rink management, uses facility

Fields

Each party mows/fertilizes their fields, and paints football, lacrosse and soccer fields



- Inventory includes 10 green fields, 4 soccer fields, 12 baseball/softball fields, and one each: football field, lacrosse field, stadium/track
- District schedules all fields and hires summer helpers
- City made gate for the Quads

Public Works



- Valuable partnership
- Road salt storage
- District clears sidewalk along Warner by OHA and plows from St.
 Andrew's to water tower
- City participates in ECFE Vehicle Fair

Share knowledge and expertise on everything public works related – strong working relationship with district grounds crew, building and grounds supervisor, public works staff



Plus, Community Education works with city's:

 Environmental Commission on RITE of Spring – publicity, planning, scheduling

Parks Commission publicize annual skating party and director attends monthly meetings to share information

City active with Safe Routes to School efforts
