Summit Hill Jr. High Baseball Team

The Summit Hill baseball team won their IESA 3A State Tournament with a convincing 10 - 1 victory over Morton Junior High in the state championship game on Saturday, October 1st at Eastside Centre in East Peoria, IL. The Spartans advanced to the state championship by defeating Rochester 10 - 0 in five innings on Friday, and by defeating Champaign Edison in walk - off fashion on Saturday morning by a final of 5 - 4 in eight innings. Tyler Osmanski provided the game winning hit to send the Spartans to the IESA 3A State Championship. Osmanski, Lucas Ervin, Aidan Dillon, and Casey Mikrut all pitched well for the Spartans on the mound over the weekend, combining for 23 strikeouts and only four walks over 19 innings. In the state championship contest, Mikrut pitched a complete game while only allowing one run. Offensively, the team combined for 12 hits in route to the title, with Osmanski, Ervin, Kaden Dangman, Matthew Ritter, and Zach Viravec all contributing two hits. Ervin had 3 RBI's in the victory and so did Dangman, including a solo homerun. Curtiss Crossly, Mikrut, and Osmanski each had two runs scored. The state championship completes a record setting season for the Spartans in program wins (27), varsity wins (23), and they are the first program to win three 3A state titles in IESA 3A history (2008, 2014).
