### Summary:

Overall work on the project is generally proceeding well. Masons, roofers, mechanical and electrical sub-contractors on site and progressing on the project.

Work continues up at the second floor level, masonry crews working on installing the brick veneer on the exterior walls. Interior wall tile being installed in the restrooms. Gym/Cafeteria, roof structure in place, installation of roof to begin shortly. Crews on site, paving on bus loop in place with final grading ongoing for parking lots and entry drives.

Overall, the quality of the work completed to date is satisfactory. Plans and specifications have met all TEA guidelines and mandates for a middle school facility and is being constructed with local codes and ordinances.

Progress zoom meetings are underway to review the progress of the construction and the following site work activities are noted: SITEWORK

- 1. Overall, site is being maintained in proper condition. See Photos 1 and 2.
- 2. Testing Agency has been on site doing field density tests and taking samples for quality control.
- 3. Concrete paving of bus loop in place. See Photos 1 and 2.

#### AREA A

- 4. Exterior brick veneer being installed in classroom wing. See Photo 3 and 4.
- 5. MEP work and ceiling above restrooms being installed in typical classroom wing. See **Photos 7 and 8.**

#### AREA C

- 6. Brick veneer being installed at student entry by bus loop student drop-off area. See **Photo 5**.
- 7. Roof structure in place above Gym, roofing to begin shortly. See Photo 6.
- Based on our on-site observations and to the best of the Architect's knowledge, information and belief the work has progressed as indicated and the quality of the work is in conformance with the construction documents and specifications.




