TITLE:	Approval of the Associate of Arts Degree as the College's Multidisciplinary Associate Degree
DISCUSSION:	Senate Bill 1189 requires each Texas public community college to adopt a multidisciplinary associate degree that includes the Texas core curriculum and courses selected by the student to satisfy associate degree requirements and has the flexibility to prepare students for their intended field of study at a four-year university. All students identifying the multidisciplinary studies degree as their intended major must meet with an academic advisor upon completion of 30 semester credit hours to complete a degree plan.
DISTRICT PRESIDENT'S RECOMMENDATION:	The District President recommends approval of the associate of arts degree as Collin College's multidisciplinary associate degree.
SUGGESTED MOTION:	"Mr. Chairman, I make a motion that the Board of Trustees of Collin County Community College District approves the Associate of Arts degree as Collin College's multidisciplinary studies degree program as required by Senate Bill 1189."
