**23194** **Report on Growth Scenarios:** Superintendent Tom Crowe presented low-growth predictions provided by ECISD's demographer Population & Survey Analysts. By 2019, according to this low-growth prediction the district would have an overall enrollment of 36,200, compared to current enrollment of 31,800. (Permian would have more than 5,000 students and Odessa High would have a little more than 4,000 students)

Mr. Crowe plans to reach out to the community for their thoughts and ideas of what they would like the district to look like in the coming years.

If it was decided a bond was needed, a committee would be formed.
