SUMMARY:

This item requests approval of the quotes from Heinemann in the amount of \$324,476.20 for the Instructional Materials adoption for teacher instructional resources.

BOARD GOAL:

Growth & Management - demonstrate effective and efficient management of district resources

PREVIOUS BOARD ACTION:

The Board approved the Instructional Materials adoption for teacher instructional resources on April 9, 2019.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The Curriculum Department requested various teacher instructional materials quotes from three (3) vendors. The quotes were reviewed by the requesting content areas within the Curriculum Department to ensure items quoted maintained the current District curriculum standard along with item pricing. The quotes from Heinemann total \$324,476.20.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES:

The new teacher instructional resources will provide curriculum items within the content areas of Phonics Instruction K-2 and Readers & Writers Workshop K-5 Districtwide. The Readers & Writers Workshop K-5 kits are additional materials to support growth positions across the district. The classroom libraries will support the implementation of Readers and Writers workshop at identified project campuses. The teacher instructional resources will be purchased through the Denton ISD RFP #1802-05. This purchase is being brought for approval in accordance with the District's CH (local) policy.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:

The cost will be borne through the Instructional Materials Allotment budget.

BENEFIT OF ACTION:

The approval of this purchase will allow for the District to order the teacher instructional resources and arrange for delivery during the 2019-2020 school year.

SUPERINTENDENT'S RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the quotes from Heinemann for the Instructional Materials adoption for teacher instructional resources in the amount of \$324,476.20 be approved.
