Why This Year Is Different?

- The 2026–27 school year presents a unique challenge, with Labor Day falling unusually late on **September 7, 2026**, impacting the overall structure of the school year.
- In response, the Minnesota Legislature is temporarily allowing districts to start school **before Labor Day** without requiring the usual statutory waivers, creating additional planning flexibility.
- The Calendar Committee, representing multiple buildings, departments, and staff groups, spent several months reviewing data, comparing options, and modeling scenarios.



Calendar Committee Process



Representation

A committee representing various buildings, departments, and staff came together to ensure all voices were heard.



Modeling Options

We set out to develop two distinct sets of calendars: **Pre-Labor Day** start and **Post-Labor Day** start to compare directly.



Community Focus

Discussions centered on balancing instructional hours, contract requirements, family routines and community expectations.



Before Labor Day Start

Benefit:

- Ends school in early June

Concerns:

- Disrupts long-standing Minnesota traditions
- Conflicts with:
 - Late-summer vacations
 - Cabin weekends
 - State Fair
- Likely higher early-year absences
- Earliest allowed start: **September 1** (4-day first week)



After Labor Day Start

Benefits:

- Aligns with long-standing family and community expectations
- Preserves traditional Minnesota school start routines

Concerns:

- With Labor Day on September 7, pushes the school year deep into June
- Shortens summer break significantly
- Strong feedback against ending school in mid-June



Finding the Middle Ground

Committee built a calendar that:

- Starts **Tuesday, September 8**
- Ends **Friday, June 4** (students & graduation)
- Meets all student/staff day requirements
- Balances trimesters and instructional time
- Minimizes disruption to families and staff



Conference Improvements

What We Heard:

- Evening-only conferences do not work for all families
- Teachers reported long, exhausting days with limited prep time

What Changed:

- Added a daytime conference option on October 14
- October 9 adjusted to support quality preparation:
 - Morning: Professional Learning
 - Afternoon: Grading and planning

Benefits:

- Improves access and flexibility for families
- Provides teachers meaningful preparation time
- Creates a more balanced and sustainable conference experience

Activities & Athletics

Fall Conflicts:

Late start increases preseason practices before school begins. This may create scheduling challenges for families in late August.

Spring Conflicts:

Spring Break (Mar 22-26) occurs *after* spring sports start. This creates potential travel and participation conflicts for varsity athletes.

** These impacts were weighed carefully as part of the committee's overall decision-making process.*

Committee Recommendation

After Labor Day Start with Students Done on June 4

This calendar:

- Honors Minnesota's traditional school start expectations
- Avoids an unusually late end to the school year
- Protects instructional time and maintains a balanced academic year
- Addresses professional learning and conference needs
- Minimizes disruptions to athletics, activities, and family routines
- Fits within all district and staff contract parameters

This recommendation reflects a thoughtful compromise and the collective work of a committee committed to supporting teaching, learning, and the well-being of our school community.
