### **2007-2008 Board Goals**

The following represents the cumulative work of the Beeville ISD Board of Trustees through June 11, 2007, to provide the Board and Superintendent of Schools direction and priorities for the 2007-2008 school year. The process for determining goals included a facilitator from the Education Service Center, Region II. The Superintendent will attempt to address all of the goals, report progress intermittently, and provide a summary at the time of the annual evaluation.

The goals for 2007-2008 are to:

1. Continue documentation and sharing of results related to students' progress after graduation
2. Measure progress toward becoming a professional learning community
3. Achieve academic excellence as measures by:
  - State accountability (recognized or above)
  - Federal accountability
  - Comprehensive discussion of what academic excellence means and our progress (maybe a public forum format)
  - Number of students in dual credit courses
  - Number of students participating in UIL
  - Communicating academic excellence as we study best practices
4. Continue to implement the plan for parent and community support for education
5. Continue to implement the plan for increased efficiency of operations
