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Purpose of Waiver

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Three-Year Certification Plan

- **2025–2026:**
 - Enroll in iTeach in May 2026
 - Begin required coursework and training modules
 - Schedule and complete program advisor field observations
 - Prepare and register for TExES exams

- **2026–2027:**
 - Complete remaining coursework and modules
 - Pass required TExES and PPR exams
 - **By Start of 2027–2028 School Year:**
 - Progress toward full certification
 - **2028–2029:**
 - Obtain full standard certification in assigned subject area
 - Continue teaching in Dublin ISD
