2010-2011 Rollback Election Calendar
(Not on Uniform Election Day)

- 1) April 30 – Certified Estimated Tax Roll from Tarrant Appraisal District.
(Necessary for calculation of rollback rate).
- 2) May 13 – Regular Board meeting
 - a) Board of Trustees makes final decision on salary and benefits.
 - b) Meeting of governing body to decide on public meeting date on budget and proposed tax rate.
- 3) May 16 – "NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING TO DISCUSS BUDGET AND PROPOSED TAX RATE" published 10 to 30 days before public meeting.
- 4) May 27 – Regular Board Meeting
 - a) Public meeting on budget and proposed tax rate. School Board may adopt budget and tax rate after the public meeting. Or, the board may adopt either the budget or the tax rate. If the board waits to adopt the budget, another public meeting to discuss budget will need to be held.
 - b) The first meeting able to adopt a tax rate; and,
 - c) Call for a rollback election
 - d) Budget must be adopted by August 31
- 5) June 15 – Last day from May 16th published notice to call meeting to adopt tax rate and call election. (Regular meeting June 17th)
 - a) Public meeting on budget and proposed tax rate. School Board may adopt budget and tax rate after the public meeting. Or, the board may adopt either the budget or the tax rate. If the board waits to adopt the budget, another public meeting to discuss budget will need to be held.
 - b) The first meeting able to adopt a tax rate; and,
 - c) Call for a rollback election
 - d) Budget must be adopted by August 31
- 6) June 26 – First day to have rollback election (Called May 27)
- 7) July 23 - "NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING TO DISCUSS BUDGET AND PROPOSED TAX RATE" published 10 to 30 days before public meeting.
(For August 2 Meeting)
- 8) August 3 – Last day to call election that will **not** be held on uniform Election Day. Public meeting on budget and proposed tax rate.

- a) School Board may adopt budget and tax rate after the public meeting. Or, the board may adopt either the budget or the tax rate. If the board waits to adopt the budget, another public meeting to discuss budget will need to be held.
- b) The first meeting able to adopt a tax rate; and,
- c) Call for a rollback election
- d) Budget must be adopted by August 31

9) September 1 – First day to have an election if called August 2.

10) October 3 – Last day to have rollback election before uniform Election Day.
(No elections within 30 days of a uniform election day (black out period.)
