INFORMATIONAL REPORT:

An on-site visit from the Texas Education Agency will occur January 13 – 17, 2014. Selection of local education agencies (LEAs) for on-site program effectiveness reviews is based on a review of Performance-Based Monitoring Analysis System (PBMAS) results, as well as longitudinal student performance and program effectiveness data. On-site monitoring is designed to examine the origins of continuing low performance and program effectiveness concerns, and identify systemic concerns that may be impacting student performance.

For 2013-2014, the United ISD is staged for interventions at a stage 3 for bilingual education/English as a second language (BE/ESL) and residential facility monitoring, stage 2 for No Child Left Behind (NCLB), and stage 1 for career and technical education (CTE).
