KHS places fifth overall at UIL State Championships: Six members of the Keller High UIL Academic Team competed recently at the state UIL Championships in Austin, bringing home a first-place state ranking in team Accounting and a fifth-place finish overall. Individually, Carl Reyes placed first in Accounting while Nick Saunders took second and Brandon Brumley placed fourth. This was the first time any of these students had competed in Accounting. ## **KISD Seniors Offered Millions In Scholarships**

Keller ISD seniors have been offered a total of \$21,533,535 in scholarships, up 70 percent from last year. At Keller High, 32 percent of graduating seniors received offers totaling more than \$11.14 million. At Fossil Ridge High, 25 percent of graduating seniors received offers totaling more than \$10.38 million.
