The Unity Board of Education requires that each high school student be enrolled on a full time basis.

Full time status requires that a minimum of $\frac{6}{4}$ classes excluding physical education/weightlifting be scheduled for all students. Students are encouraged to take more than the minimum class road.

Students enrolled in a minimum of 6 4 classes (equivalent to 3 credits) may take a combination of on-site or virtual school coursework. To be eligible to participate in Wisconsin Interscholastic Athletics students must meet WIAA enrollment requirements. Maintaining eligibility with attendance, grading and GPA requirements will be followed for all classes.

Exceptions to the above policy may be made regarding EEN students based on individual IEP's or for students enrolled in an approved Education for Employment work program.

Middle school and elementary programs require a full day of study. Principals may establish home-bound instructional programs based on unique, short-term needs of students.

The Unity District shall not discriminate in standards on the basis of sex, race, national origin, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation or physical, mental, emotional or learning disability. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
