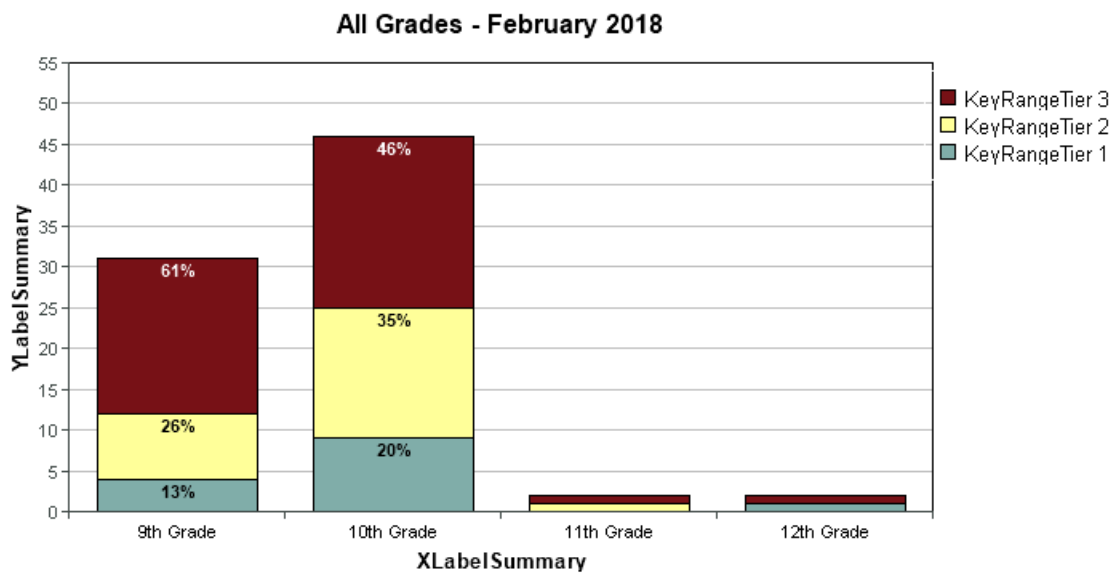
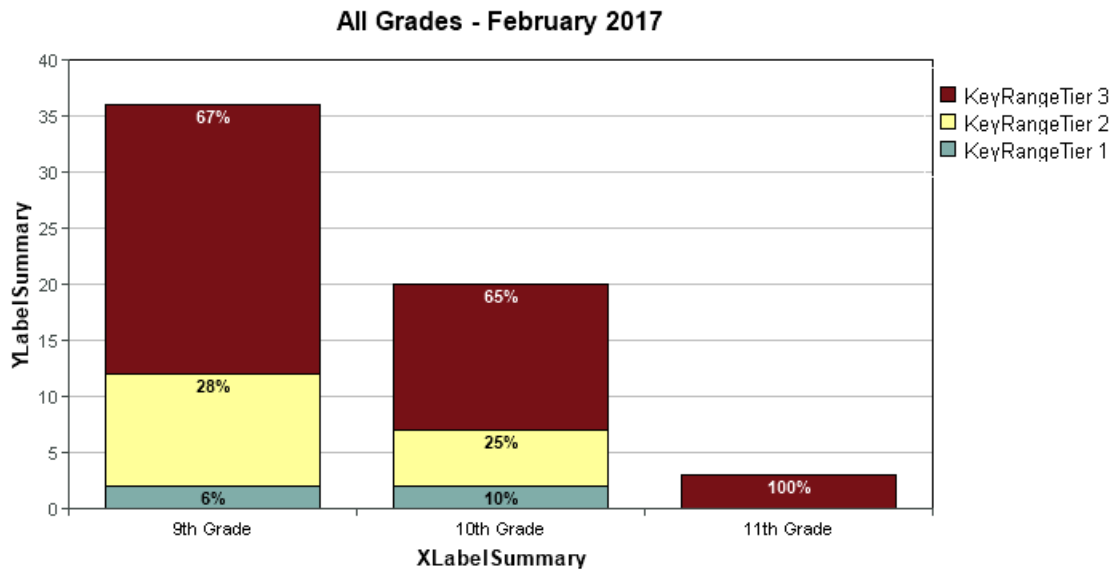


ISIP-Literacy Assessment

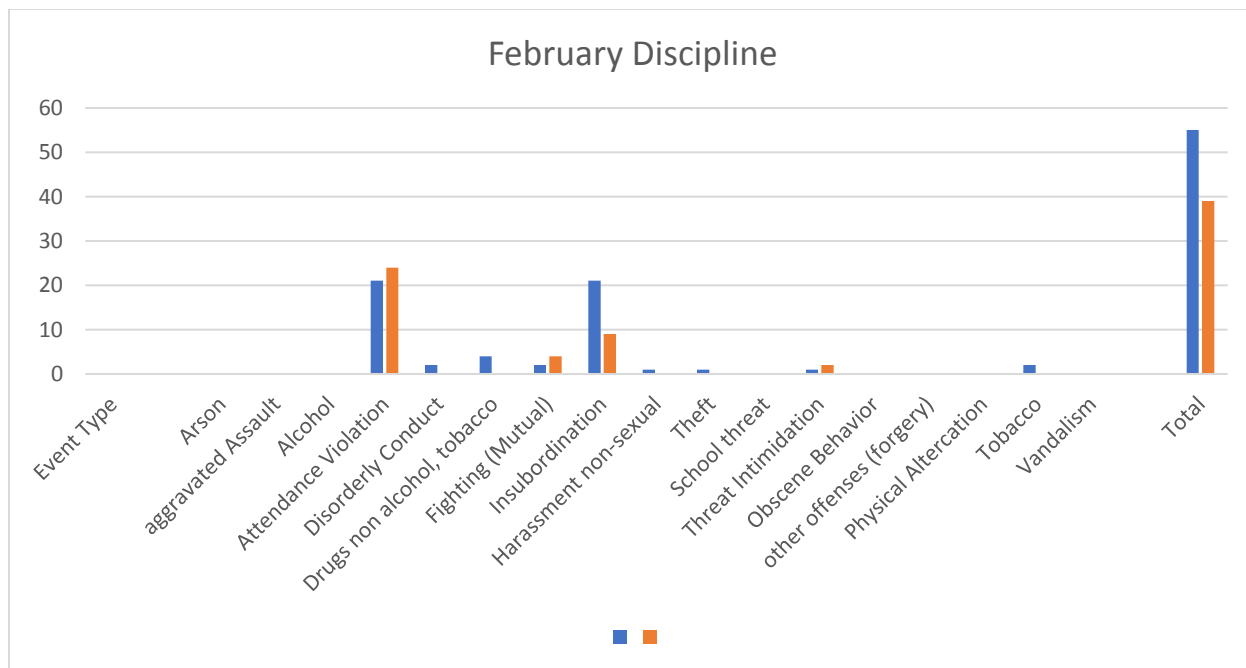
