Increase Dental Hygiene Student Fees for Trajecsys Clinical Tracker Software

**Recommendation:** 

Approve Increased Dental Hygiene Student Fee, Effective Spring 2024

## **Background and Rationale:**

Trajecsys is a clinical & assessment software that tracks dental hygiene students' clinical work such as time on task, completion of patient requirements, evaluation of competency attainment, documentation of daily grades, and tracking of patient demographics. The digital tracking system decreases hard-copy files of student progress, saves personnel resources, reduces costs, and allows 24/7 student access to clinical grades. Student grades remain confidential since electronic files are only accessible to faculty and the student. Faculty access to shared electronic files on student progress provides opportunity for early intervention and remediation if student progress falls below expectations. Students may access their progress records 24/7 via computer or cell phone thus reducing delays in instructor feedback. And the tracking software demonstrates compliance with accrediting body requirements to assess and support student learning.

The request is to add a \$50 fee to four dental hygiene clinical courses. Add \$50 fee to DHYG 1431 & 1261. Increase fees from \$200 to \$250 in DHYG 2362 & 2363.
