2025 Evacuation Drill Cameron Elementary School October 27, 2025

On October 9, 2025 Cameron Elementary School conducted an evacuation/relocation drill. Teachers and students were notified in advance, with extra consideration for our special needs students and any others with injuries that prevented them from walking. Classroom teachers were given specific instructions about the drill and a message to share with their students. We had all students in grades PK-4 participate in this drill. The students were in their classrooms at the time of the drill. Each group left the school with their classroom in a non threatening environment. Students walked through part of town to Sportsman's Park where they boarded school buses. From here, buses took students and staff to the relocation destination, Cameron Middle School.

At our relocation, students sat in grade level designated areas with their classroom in a straight line. At the relocation destination, we did a question and answer session with staff and students. We talked about how and why we did the drill. We also went over the contents of green buckets and what all of the specific jobs would be. Staff and students also practiced a couple scenarios.

All staff and students were accounted for during the drill. After addressing the students, we had buses available to drive students back to Cameron Elementary School.

Successful highlights:

- We had alternative busing for students with disabilities.
- We safely had our students and staff walk to the Sportsman's Park.
- All students and staff were accounted for.
- The organization of the plan was well done and seemed to work in a drill situation.
- We created new student information forms. They are more comprehensive for student pickup. We also added a signature line for the person that picks the student up.
- We changed the structure of the parent sign-in tables and the relocation table. This will help create a better flow.

Focus areas for the next drill:

- Would we want to have an alternative bus pick up location in case of an emergency?
 This would be something closer than Sportsman's Park.
- Identification of alternative rooms for staff to go to when working with students.(Ex. School Counselor)
