

KAUFMAN ISD - MAINTENANCE REPORT DECEMBER 2025


The Kaufman ISD maintenance team has continued to work on improvement projects around the district. In addition to those projects, there were over 200 work orders completed during the month of November.




We continue to build and improve the automated gates across the district. Here, a crew modifies two gates at the service center.






The modification will improve performance and security, as well as improve the accessibility process for buses and school vehicles in the district.
