<u>Overview</u>

The group showed a great deal of adaptability with the ever changing environment. The accomplishment was truly a team effort!
- The Freshman Class Officers with the assistance of class advisers organized a foodraiser event for the high school that took place prior to holiday break. The student body did a great job supporting our community with their donations. Thank you to everyone that participated. Together, THS collected 264 food items and \$191.00.
- The Senior Class will be presenting throughout January to various staff members regarding their individual academic and career plans. Each senior will present to 2 staff members regarding what they discovered about themselves throughout school and the experiences they had to develop this understanding. They are also presenting their post high school plans and how they determined this path. This activity is a part of the District ACP plan and we look to our first year of implementation. We are excited for our seniors to showcase themselves and look forward to listening to each of them present their personal story.
- Semester 1 is ending on Tuesday, January 19th. High School staff will be utilizing January 20th to finalize student grades and many also will prepare for new semester courses to begin on January 21st.
- The high school course scheduling process will be starting in late January/early February.
