## **Background Information:**

- The KISD Citizens Bond Advisory Committee (CBAC) recommends that the KISD Board of Trustees call a bond election for March 5, 2005, to address the issues of growth, safety, security, access and critical repairs.
- The Committee further recommends that the Board of Trustees adopt the following recommendations:
  - That the Board of Trustees direct the Superintendent to establish a KISD Bond Oversight Committee to monitor and review the monthly use of funds, the District's adherence to the bond projects as approved, and the timeliness of projects.
  - That the Board of Trustees direct the Superintendent to evaluate current District owned properties, identify property deemed unusable for District purposes, and market these properties in a way to maximize their value in the acquisition of new properties for future District use.
  - That the Board of Trustees direct the Superintendent to create a plan of action to address priority building and maintenance projects identified in the 2004 bond program but excluded from the current proposal.
