Grant is from First Book, Intel Corporation, and CDW Logistics. Districts have to apply with the intent of distributing the 350 Chromebooks to Title students. We applied with the intent of targeting students at Evergreen. If awarded the grant, we would receive the devices by the end of August. Local Education Agencies (LEAs), Education Service Agencies (ESAs), and district leadership are invited to apply for up to 350 Windows and/or Chromebook PCs for their Title I students to use for remote learning during the current COVID-19 emergency and beyond.
