11. Presentation: Radio Program - Jonny Reinhardt

Reinhardt provided an update on recent and ongoing projects within the broadcast program. Students recently completed a Pecha Kucha project, described as short, informal presentations used to help students get to know one another. Three outdated computers have been replaced, and work is underway to implement a new automation system, with additional equipment to be upgraded, or replaced as needed. These improvements will be supported through partnerships with the Michigan Association of Broadcasters, Midwest Family Marketing and Media, broadcast and audio engineers, and Niles-based Theory One Productions. Enrollment remains strong, with 21 students last trimester and approximately 16 this trimester. Students continue to create content that extends beyond the classroom, including a recent interview with New Buffalo Township Supervisor Michelle Heit regarding the future of Veterans Park. Looking ahead, Reinhardt plans to pursue collaboration with other broadcast CTE programs across the county and state and to organize field trips to broadcast and television-related facilities.
