Report/Discussion Items

Presentation of Broadband Update: Superintendent Dr. Scott Muri and Chief Technology Officer Dr. Kellie Wilks presented an update on the work to expand broadband to all of Ector County. Noting that our school district is working on a plan to help find a long-term solution to provide broadband (high speed) internet access to all students and families throughout the county. A cross section of community leaders were brought into the study and agreed internet access for all should be a priority project for Ector County. ECISD is leading that work. Research shows many gaps in coverage exist locally; the most rural areas typically have the slowest and least reliable internet options; and the District's goal is for all residents to have affordable access to speeds of 100 megabits/second downloads and 10 megabit/second uploads. Trustees saw maps of cell phone towers, data of coverage areas, and learned that 1 in 5 ECISD students rarely or never has reliable internet access at home.

Superintendent Muri told Trustees a panel of national connectivity experts are already working with us to study the situation and help find a long-term solution for Odessa and Ector County.

<u>Discussion of ECISD's Opening of School Plans</u>: Superintendent Dr. Scott Muri walked the Trustees through a brief recap of the plan for starting school – the next day (August 12). By the numbers: it is about a 50-50 split between parents choosing remote learning or in-person learning for their student; 2,851 students are registered to ride buses, about half of the normal number of riders; and the number of teacher vacancies is down dramatically from one year ago (currently there are 91 vacancies in elementary schools and 31 in secondary schools). A total of 407 teachers have been hired this year. He reminded board members school starts with a limited number of students on campus. Groups of students will be phased-in over a period of weeks.
