Fall Sports-

Volleyball-

Volleyball has had three matches thus far this season and they are 1-2. The volleyball team lost a lot of players to graduation last year. There are very few girls with varsity experience. Coach Fouts has been working the girls hard. There are a total of 25 girls out for volleyball this season, which is down 3 from last year.

Football-
