Recommendation:

That the Lyon County School District Board of Trustees approve the deletion of Policy IGADA

Background Information:

It is recommended that the Board of Trustees delete this policy as it is out of date and unnecessary as the district moves forward with its growth and expansion of Career and Technical Educational (CTE) Programs across the district. The policy, as it reads, cites outdated labor statistics and was created during a time when the district did not have the number of Career and Technical Pathways as it does today. LCSD offers pathways in CTE that align with the 14 Career Clusters that serve as the primary organizing structures for CTE programs as outlined by Advance CTE.

There is no impact on staff or students, as these pictures do not exist in the schools at this time. Additionally, the District's work on our Portrait of a Learner stresses the importance of lifelong learning, connectedness, student ownership of learning as well as discovery learning which is being done in all of our schools. It is part of the district's priorities to have Work Based Learning infused in Tier I instruction and the district is currently tracking activities and the number of students impacted as part of our Acing Accountability Innovative Practice.
