



## What is Alpena County Regional Airport (APN)?







- APN is a Class 4, FAA Part 139 airport which means we have scheduled passenger service for aircraft up to 50 seats
- APN also supports daily cargo flights from FedEx and UPS
- APN is Shared Use airport, meaning a civilian owned airport that has a military tenant (Alpena Combat Readiness Training Center)
- APN also serves the County as an emergency equipment storage site





## What revenue does the Airport generate?

- APN has land and facility leases
- Airlines embarking passengers at Alpena pay \$4.37 per passenger to the Airport (PFC)
- The Airport also charges ramp and landing fees as well as a fuel flow charge paid by the fueling agency, Huron Aviation
- As part of the National Plan of Integrated Airport Systems (NPIAS) APN is eligible for FAA Airport Improvement Program (AIP) grants





## What the Airport Improvement Program (AIP)?

- Provides >\$3.18B annually to >3,300 eligible airports, distributed based on PAX and cargo
- Airports with >10k enplanements qualify for a min. \$1M/yr. for infrastructure
- AIP does not pay for operating cost, and generally doesn't pay for maintenance costs or revenue generating facilities
- Project funding based on Eligibility, Justification, Cost, and Fundability
