B. Aledo ISD 2025 Committee Progress Report

At the most recent 2025 Committee meetings of April 1st and 15th, the committee members focused on working toward a grade configuration recommendation for future submission to Trustees.

Trustees should also be aware that the sub-committees were condensed into three final sub-committees. The “New Facilities” and “Existing Facilities/Maintenance” committees have been fused into one committee now called the “Facilities/Maintenance” Committee. With the work completed on grade configuration and demographics, there no longer exists a need for the original four sub-committee structure.

All three committees will now begin the process of reviewing facilities, technology and safety/security with an eye toward the recommendations coming to trustees later in this process.

On and editorial note, the committee’s work to date has been excellent. There are a number of voices being heard from across the district. The expertise being brought to the table by this group is also stellar. Administration is very thankful for their level of volunteerism and expects great things to come from their work.

C. TRUSTEE ELECTION

Early voting begins on April 28th at 7:00 AM at the Administration Building with the general election being held on May 10th. Voting for the general election will be held by voter precinct.
