






# **Average Class Size**








# Classification of Enrolled Students: 1<sup>st</sup>-time Freshmen ONLY (N=1184)






#### **Grade Distribution: ENG 131**




#### **Grade Distribution: ENG 131**

## **Summary Points: Student Population**

- •30% of all ENG131 courses & 19 % of all SC 135 where QEP
- •Average class size of ENG 131 courses was 30 students, SC 135 enrolled an average of 50 students
- •57% of all first time freshman enrolled in ENG 131, 22% were QEP courses.
  - •42% of all first-time freshman in enrolled in SC 135, 12% were QEP courses.
  - •The vast majority of students (greater than 90%) enrolled in ENG 131 & SC 153 were freshmen or sophomores.

### **Summary Points: ENG 131 Grades**

- •6% of students enrolled in QEP ENG 131 received an A (includes A+, A, & A-), in comparison to non-QEP ENG 131, which yielded 8% with these grades.
- •Greater similarity was revealed in analyzing ENG 131 students that received a grade of B- or higher. Both QEP & Non-QEP populations yielded 28% in this category.
- •Overall QEP ENG 131 yielded a higher percent (63%) of students with a C or Better in comparison with the Non-QEP group (54%).
  - •Both ENG 131 groups showed similarity in the percent (approx. 18%) of students receiving an F in the course.

### **Summary Points: SC 135 Grades**

- •24% of students enrolled in QEP SC 135 received an A (includes A+, A, & A-), in comparison to non-QEP ENG 131, which yielded 47% with these grades.
- •59% of Non-QEP SC 135 students received a grade of B- or higher, while a lower percent (40%) of the QEP population fell into this category.
- •Overall Non-QEP SC 135 yielded a slightly higher percent (66%) of students with a C or Better in comparison with the QEP group (58%).
- •Both SC 135 groups showed similarity in the percent (approx. 20%) of students receiving an F in the course.
