Dr. Suzette Bloodman and her team of devoted educators implement practices that result in students having access to quality instruction on a daily basis. According to the OC model, excellent teachers and their teams at Forrest City Junior High School and the Sixth Grade Academy extend their reach to serve more students. Teachers are afforded time to plan and collaborate weekly. Additionally, Multi Classroom Leaders (MCLs) provide ongoing, real-time observations, feedback, and support to team teachers in an effort to improve instructional practices. The observation and feedback model used at FCJHS and SGA results in students receiving instructional support that reflects Forrest City School District's four priorities: strong instruction, deep engagement, grade appropriate work, and high expectations. As a second year Opportunity Culture school, the district remains committed to supporting Dr. Bloodman and her team as they embrace the tenets of the OC model.
