## News from Mr. Regal



First, I would like to take this opportunity to "THANK" all the parents, students, and staff that had a chance to come to Open House on September 20. If you were not able to attend, there will be many more occasions to visit our school during the school year.

At open house, I informed parents of a new process in dealing with student behaviors. Evergreen Elementary has created a problem solver worksheet that the student needs to fill out when they break one of our school rules: Be Safe, Be Responsible, Be Respectful, and Be Kind. After the student fills out the problem solver, they will bring it home that night and communicate to their parents about which school rule they broke and what positive choice they could make next time this issue comes up. The problem solver is a way for students to take responsibility for their behaviors and choices, but also communicate to parents what is going on at school in relation to their behaviors. After discussing the incident with your child please sign it and have them return it to their teacher the next school day. If a child does not bring it back, the teacher or a staff member will contact you with your child to discuss the incident in order to keep parents informed of their child's behavior at school. Please feel free to contact Mr. Regal if you have any questions about the school rules or the discipline process at Evergreen Elementary.

Next, this year in the Three Rivers School District, k-5 has adopted a new math curriculum called EnVisions. Grades k-2 implemented this program last year and we have added grades 3-5 this school year. This curriculum is aligned with the new Common Core State Standards for Oregon. This program allows students to work interactively daily through visual learning strategies. It also differentiates instruction based on student data and allows for every child to succeed. If you would like more information please contact the school or your child's teacher.

Finally, I would like to take this opportunity to ask parents to support your child and our school by volunteering some time throughout the year. We are currently looking for a parent or two to be on our Site Council Team. This team meets once a month and looks at the School Improvement Plan for our school. The Site Council assists the principal in setting direction for the school and how to improve the instructional program at Evergreen by looking at school data, professional development for staff, and grant opportunities for the school. We also would like to invite more parents to join our Parent Teacher Organization (PTO), which meets once a month and organizes several activities throughout the school year to raise money for our students for assemblies, field trips, and many other opportunities that we could not offer our children without the PTO. So please, feel free to contact the school and support our students and staff by volunteering some time during the school year. We have all heard the old saying "It takes a village to raise a child" and here at Evergreen Elementary we have 416 children that we deeply care about and want them to be successful academically, behaviorally, and socially.

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
