IV. INFORMATION ITEMS

A. Math Update - Self study went very well and results will be shared at the February 6^{th} BOE meeting. Math coaches and specialists will attend. One observation noticed is that math starts falling off at 4^{th} grade. In third grade, 80% of students are meeting standards, followed by 70% (4^{th} grade); 60% (5^{th} grade); 63% (6^{th} grade); 58% (7^{th} grade); 63% (8^{th} grade); 50% (11^{th} grade).

B. Summer Math - We are meeting with the Economic Development Council (EDC) to encourage local businesses to get involved in issuing math problems to get children involved while shopping. This is designed for K-12 students.

C. Gifted Programming and Identification – The committee felt it is important to not only identify gifted students, but also to create opportunities to challenge students.

D. SAT Math Class – This would be a half semester elective for students and it is expected that these will be added next year.

E. SAT Boot Camp – This 5 hour boot camp is scheduled for March 10^{th} , two weeks prior to the SAT.

F. Update on Hiring of Curriculum Director – Out of the 32 applicants, 8 candidates were interviewed, and three finalists will be interviewed on January 29, 2020.
