ACTION

A motion to approve the resolution as presented to declare a public purpose for the expenditure of district funds for the pay period of January 30, 2023 to February 3, 2023 was made by Manish Sethi and seconded by Jobby Mathew. The motion passed 7-0.

A motion was made by Nichole Bentley to adopt the Order calling a bond election to be held May 6, 2023 but the Coppell Independent School District and resolving other matters incident and related to such election. The motion was seconded by David Caviness. Nichole Bentley amended her motion to include the general and special propositions amounts of: Proposition A: 269.584 million, Proposition B: 39.472 million, Proposition C: 2.931 million. President Caviness seconded the amended motion. The motion went to a vote and the motion passed 7-0. The original motion on the floor made by Trustee Bentley to adopt the Order calling a bond election was called for a vote and the motion passed 6-1. Trustee Manish Sethi voted in opposition.

A motion was made by Manish Sethi and seconded by Jobby Mathew to adjourn the meeting. The motion carried 7-0. The meeting adjourned at 11:42 p.m.
