Below are the suggested action steps to assist in this re-organization during the Board's meeting taken from the Robert's Rules of Order handbook.

Issue Summary:

Nomination of Board Clerk:

1. <u>Board Member</u> will move to reorganize, second, and carry the motion:

"I move to open the nominations for Board Clerk."

2. Board President will formally announce:

"The floor is now open for nominations of the Clerk." NOTE: Nominations for officers do not require a second.

3. Board President will announce the names of nominees from Board members as:

- 4. <u>Board President</u> will question: "Are there further nominations for the Board Clerk?"
- 5. <u>Board President</u> will request for nominations to close if there are no more nominations as:

"Do I hear from the Board to close the nominations for Board Clerk?"

6. Board President will announce:

"unless it is a unanimous consent, a roll call vote or paper ballot is necessary."

- Repeat the names of the nominees
- Board Secretary for roll-call vote or paper ballot (Requested by members)
 Paper Ballots will be read aloud
- ♦ Announce results
- 7. The elected member may speak on their position as Clerk.
