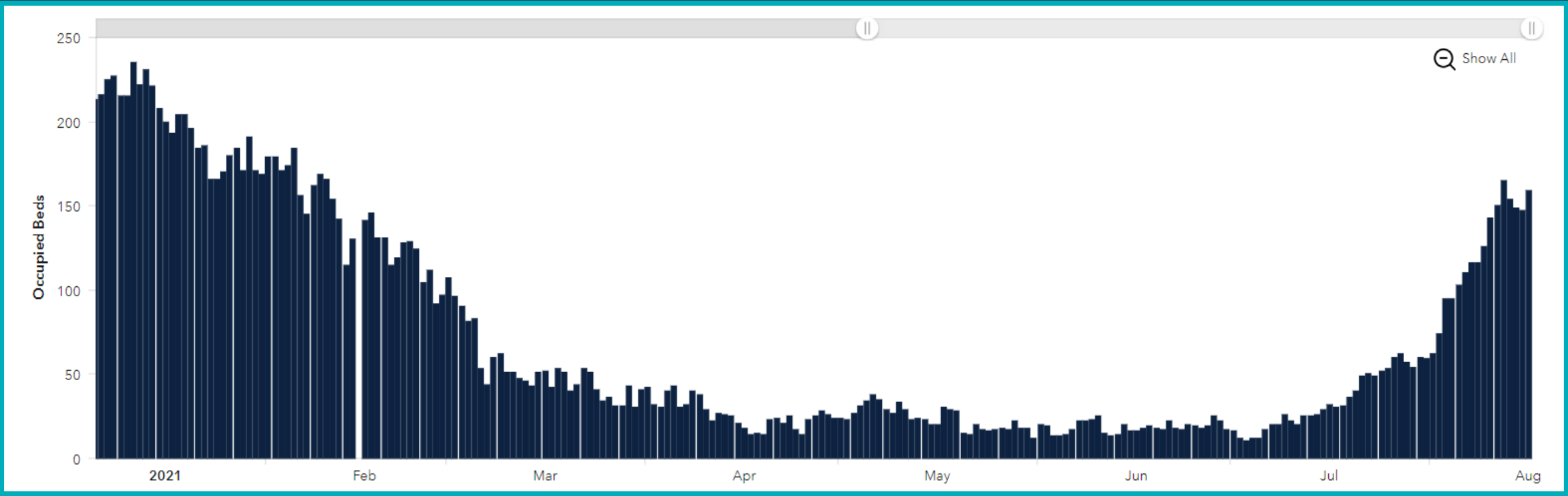

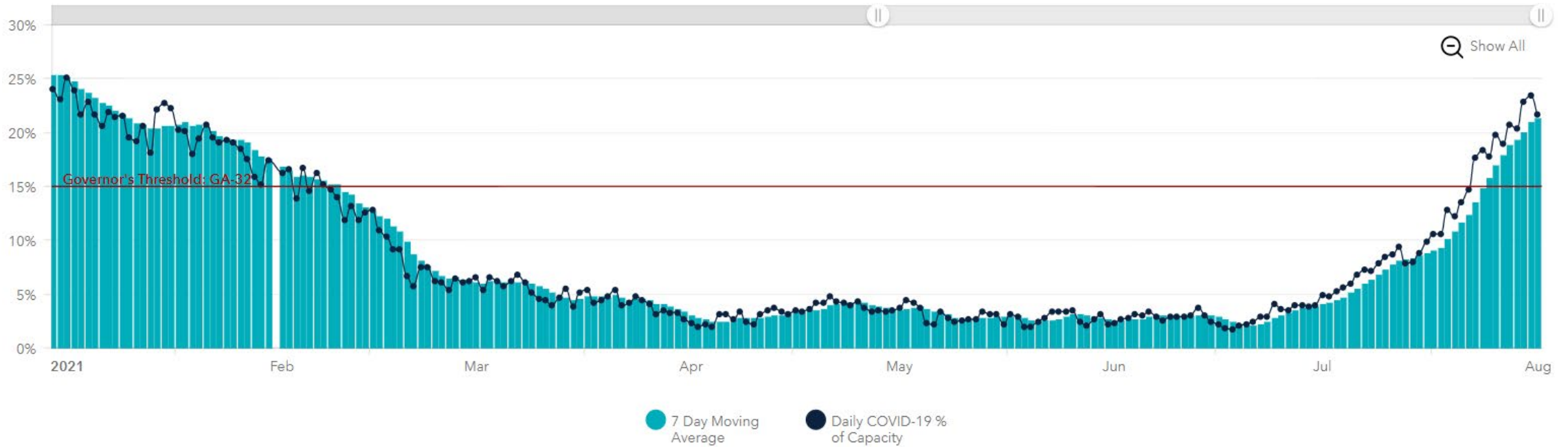

COVID-19 Hospitalizations: Denton County



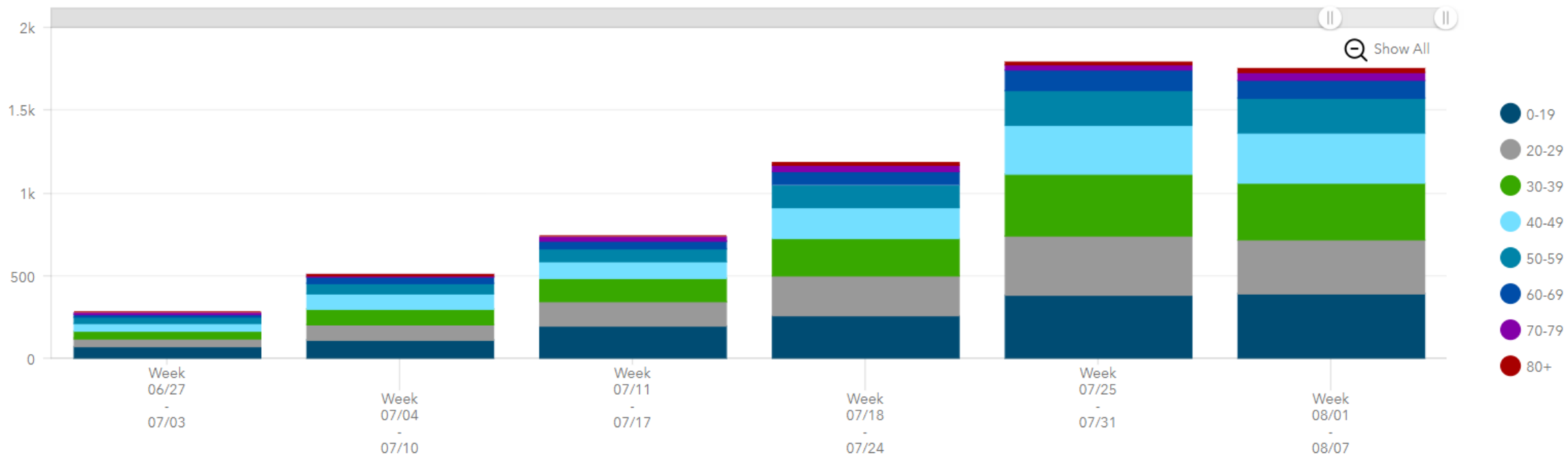
COVID-19 Percentage Inpatient Beds: Denton County

COVID-19 Percentage of Total Inpatient Beds



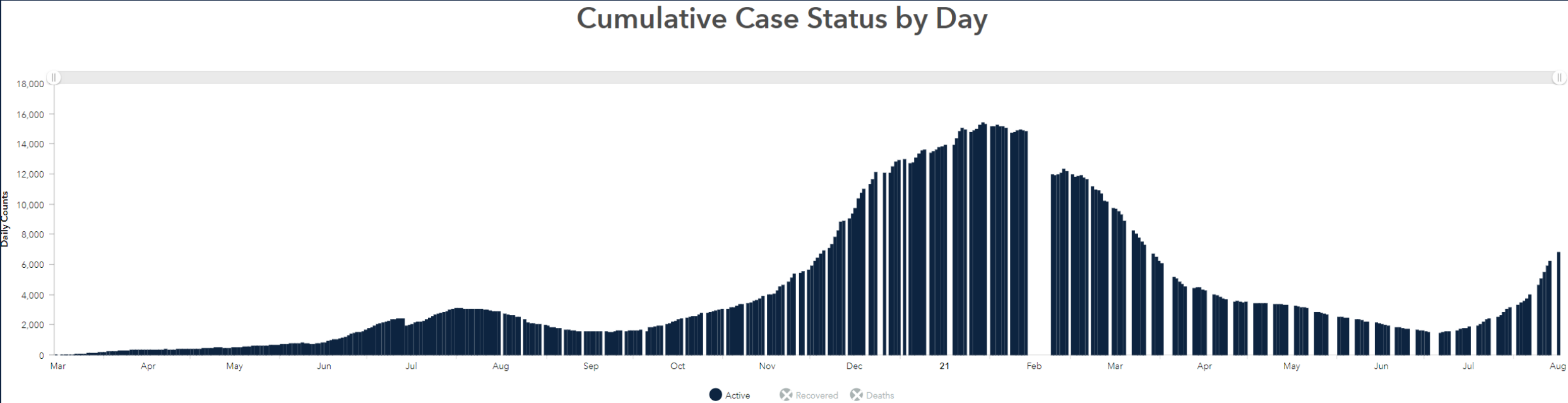
Onset of Illness by Week

Symptom Onset Weekly Cases by Age Range

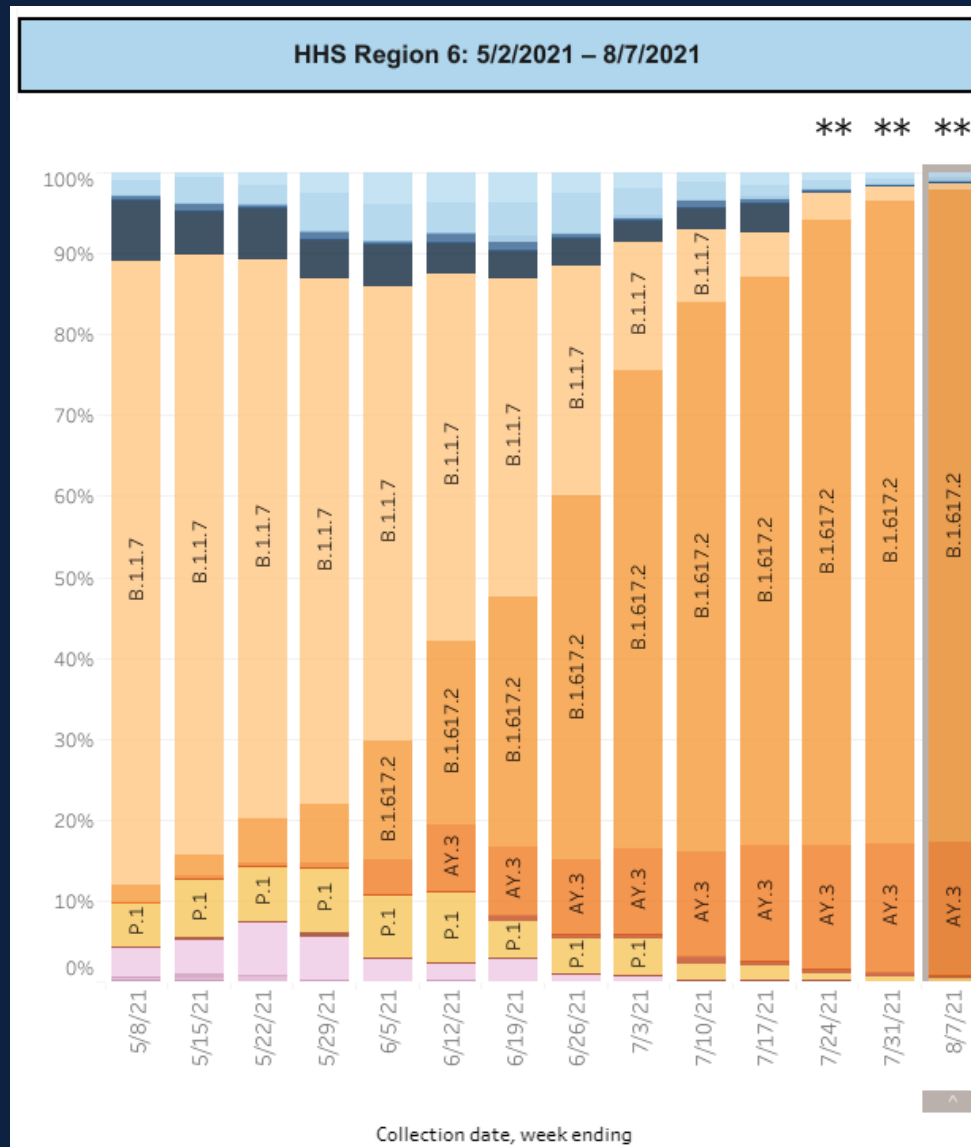


Active Cases in Denton County

As of 8AM on 8/16, DCPH received **815** total third dose registrations

Eligibility criteria for a third dose:

Individuals must be **28 days** past their second dose and must have received **either Pfizer or Moderna COVID-19 vaccines**

The CDC is recommending that moderately to severely immunocompromised people receive an additional dose of mRNA vaccine, including people who have:

- Been receiving active cancer treatment for tumors or cancers of the blood
- Received an organ transplant and are taking medicine to suppress the immune system
- Received a stem cell transplant within the last 2 years or are taking medicine to suppress the immune system
- Moderately or severe primary immunodeficiency (such as DiGeorge syndrome, Wiskott-Aldrich syndrome)
- Advanced or untreated HIV infection
- Active treatment with high-dose corticosteroids or other drugs that may suppress your immune system

COVID-19 VACCINATION & APPOINTMENT DETAILS

After you have received your first COVID-19 vaccine from DCPH, you will receive another invitation to schedule your second dose approximately 5-7 days ahead of the earliest date you can receive your second dose. If you were vaccinated with the Moderna COVID-19 vaccine, you may be vaccinated no earlier than 28 days after your first dose. If you were vaccinated with the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine, you may be vaccinated no earlier than 21 days after your first dose. No further action is required from you at this time.

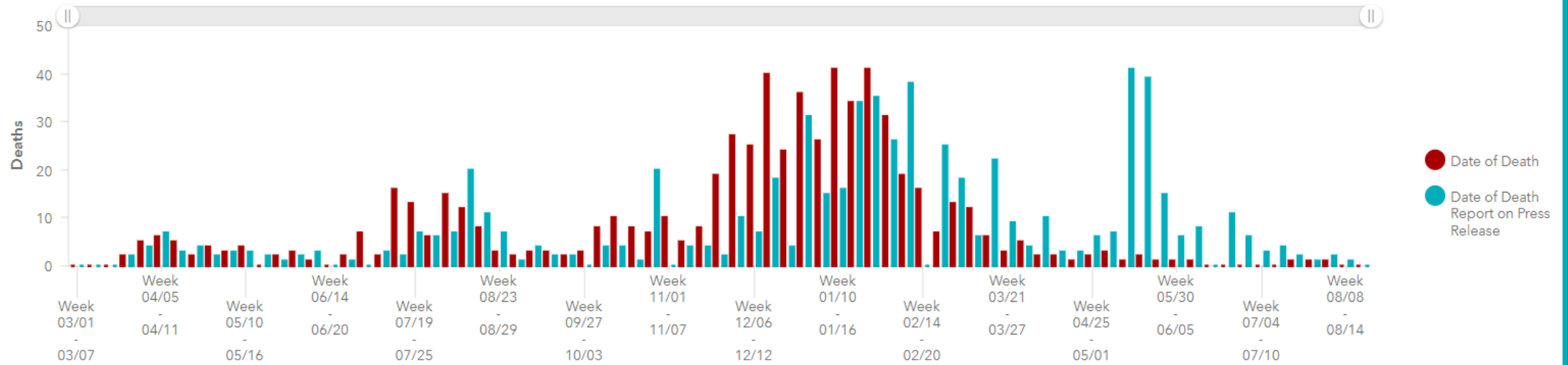
