## **Co-Curricular Athletics**

Student participation in school-sponsored co-curricular athletic activities is contingent upon the following:

- The student must meet the academic criteria set forth in Board policy Policy 6.190, Co-Curricular Activities.
- 2. A student and parent/guardian of the student must provide written permission for the student's participation by completing and signing Exhibit 7.300-E1, *Agreement to Participate*, giving the District full waiver of responsibility of the risks involved.
- 3. The student must present a current certificate of physical fitness issued by a licensed physician, an advanced practice nurse, or a physician assistant. The Exhibit 7.100-E1, State of Illinois Certificate of Child Health Examination, and Exhibit 7.300-E2, IHSA/IESA Pre-Participation Physical Examination—EvaluationForm, offered by the Illinois High School Association (IHSA) and the Illinois Elementary School Association (IESA), is are the preferred certificates of physical fitness.
- 4. The student must show proof of accident insurance coverage either by a policy purchased through the District-approved insurance plan, or a parent/guardian written statement that the student is covered under a family insurance plan.
- 5. The student must agree to follow all conduct rules and the coaches' instructions.
- 6. The student and his or her parent/guardian must provide written consent to random drug and alcohol testing pursuant to Administrative Procedure 7.240-AP2, *Co-Curricular Drug and Alcohol Testing Program*.
- 7. The student and his or her parent/guardian must:
  - a. comply with the eligibility rules of, and complete any forms required by any sponsoring association (such as the IESA and the IHSA), and
  - b. complete all forms required by the District including, without limitation, signing an acknowledgment of receiving information about concussions the Board's concussion policy (Board policy-Policy 7.305, Student Athlete Concussions and Head Injuries).

## The Superintendent or designee

- is authorized to impose additional requirements for a student to participate in co-curricular athletics, provided the requirement(s) comply with Board policy Policy 7.10, Equal Educational Opportunities, and
- 2. shall maintain the necessary records to ensure student compliance with this policy.
