Delivery Method:		
In compliance with Texas Law and Board policy, the Board of Trustees must select the delivery method that provides the best value to the District, unless the authority is delegated to an administrator. Pursuant to Board Policy CV(Local), the Board shall determine the project delivery / contract award method to be used for construction. To assist the Board, the Superintendent shall recommend the project delivery / contract award method that she determines provides the best value to the District. The Superintendent recommends the interlocal contract / purchasing cooperative delivery method as the method providing the best value for the Long Elementary Sidewalk Project. The Superintendent will submit the resulting contract to the Board for approval if the contract is valued at or above \$50,000. If the contract is less than \$50,000 the Superintendent will be authorized to negotiate and execute the contract.
