TVAH Counseling is busy wrapping up the 2024/2025 School Year.

High School Counselors have started verifying graduates as the HISD SCRMS team works through grades. We are so excited to confirm graduation and get them ready to move on with their post-secondary plans. We have held evening sessions to support our students with their transitions—whether that means enlisting in the military, moving straight into employment, or enrolling in a vocational, two-year, or four-year university. We are so proud of them and look forward to celebrating them virtually on Friday, June 6 and in Frisco on Saturday, June 7.

Middle School and Elementary School Counselors are busy supporting their students to finish the school year strong. Counseling Techs, Elementary School Counselors, and Middle School Counselors are also assisting with TSIA, which will determine eligibility for Dual Credit Enrollment with Kilgore College next year. We've received over 1000 requests from students who are interested in taking those classes with us next year.

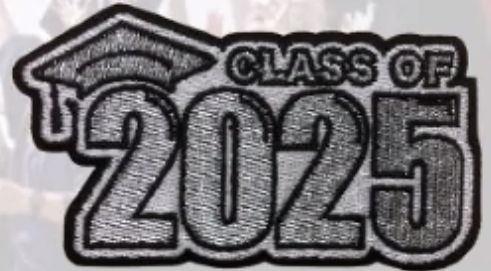
