Re: Board Policy JFAA Admission of Resident Students

The following is a brief description of the proposed modifications for the policies listed:

JKA Corporal Punishment – delete. Has not and should not be used in the District.

JKA-E Corporal Punishment - (same)

JICK Student Threats – includes new paragraph to cover cyber bullying and off-campus behavior

GBAA Sexual Discrimination and Harassment - adds principal to complaint procedure; includes reporting to DA, when warranted.

JBAA Sexual Harassment of Student - adds principal to complaint procedure; includes reporting to DA, when warranted.

JBAA-R Sexual Harassment: Investigative Procedures – minor changes; includes Title IX Coordinator in process

JBAA-E Sexual Harassment: Adult-to-Student Prohibitions – New. Cases all across the country involve “bad” behavior such as those listed. Consensus is that specific behavior prohibitions should be included in policies. (Note: The District must conduct annual staff training on sexual harassment; this new policy will be a focus of this year’s training.)

IJOA-E1 Field Trips and Excursions: Request Form and Planning Attachments – minor change

IJOA-E2 Field Trips and Excursions: Checklist – minor changes; adds reminder that all school rules apply on field trips, etc.

IJOA-E4 Field Trips and Excursions: Parent Permission Form – adds cell phone #

IJOA-R Field Trips and Excursions: Regulations – adds reminder that all school rules apply; requires any special rules to be provided in writing; adds requirement for background checks for overnight chaperones; eliminates requirement for 1 male and 1 female chaperone on all overnight trips (e.g. tennis team)

JICC Student Conduct on School Buses – adds introductory paragraph stating the Board policy to provide safe bus travel; adds bullying; miscellaneous corrections/clarifications.

JICJ Use of Cell Phone In School – changes to reflect more current student realities: allows for possession, and some use of cell phones during school day.

Behavior Incentive Program – Alternative School – I would add this as a procedure Rather than a Board policy (no need for codification at this point).
