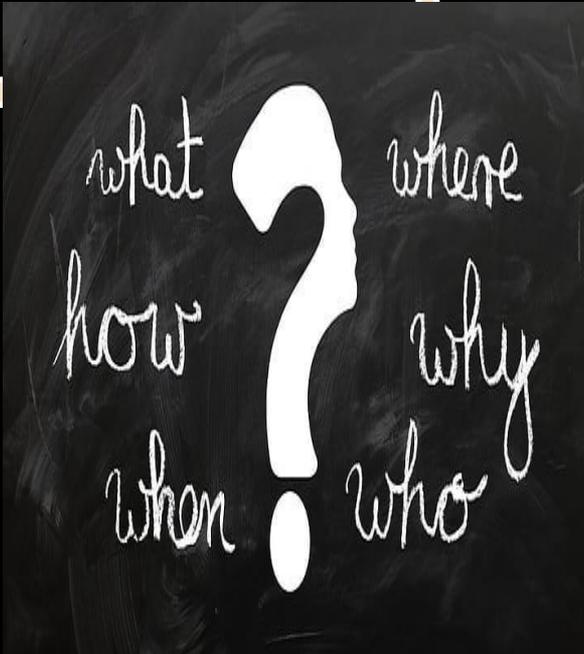

How to Read This Report



Top Row:

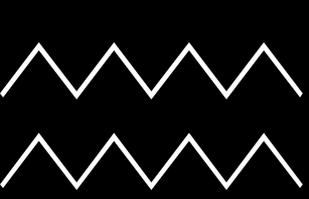
- Count of Indicators Missed for Three Consecutive Years
- 0 = No indicators met the 3-year persistent pattern
- These zeros are not red (Good Zero)

Component Section:

- The number represents component points earned
- Not the number of indicators missed
- 0 = Zero points earned- group did not meet the federal threshold
- These zeros are red (Not a Good Zero)

Red Shading:

- This performance area did not meet federal expectations
- Red shading is tied to meeting or not meeting the target, not the numeric value itself.



Frequently Asked Questions



Does this mean the campus is failing?



No. This applies to specific student groups, not overall campus performance.



Is this based on one bad year?



No. Identification requires three consecutive years.



Are there sanctions?



No automatic sanctions. The focus is support and improvement.

Do We Have
To Do?

A Local Improvement Plan must:

- Identify the student group(s) that triggered the label
- Identify the specific indicators missed (growth, achievement, etc.)
- Outline targeted strategies to address those gaps
- Include progress monitoring measures

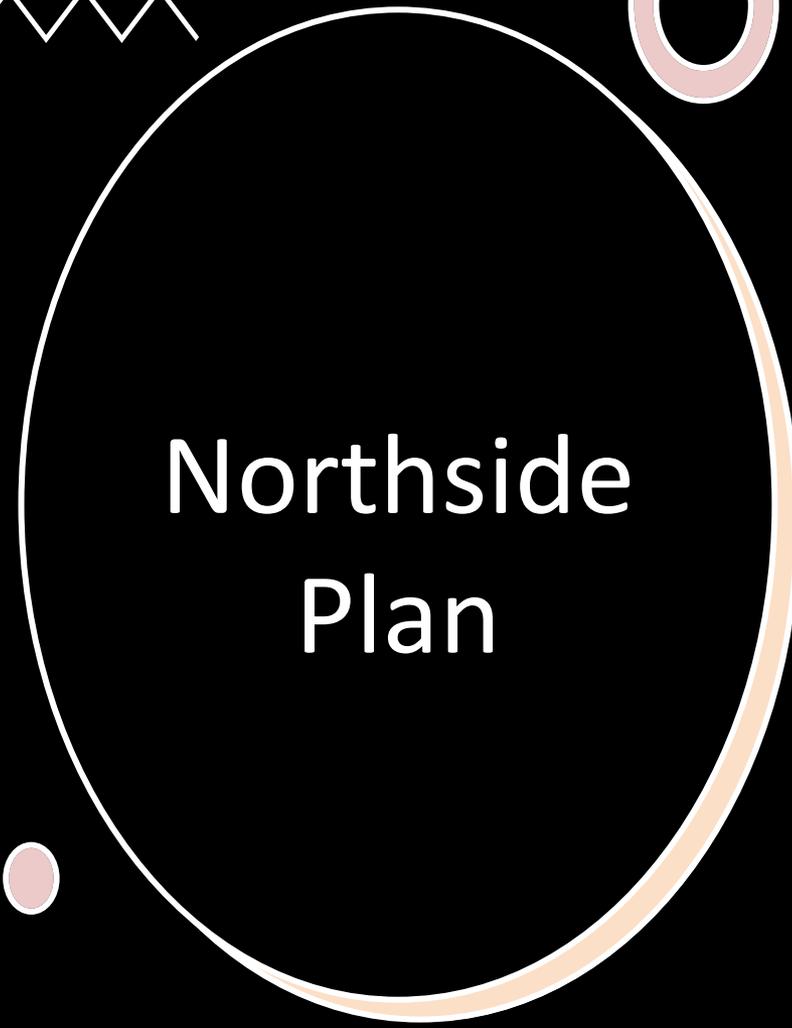

Raise Closing the Gaps scaled score for Two or More Races above 57

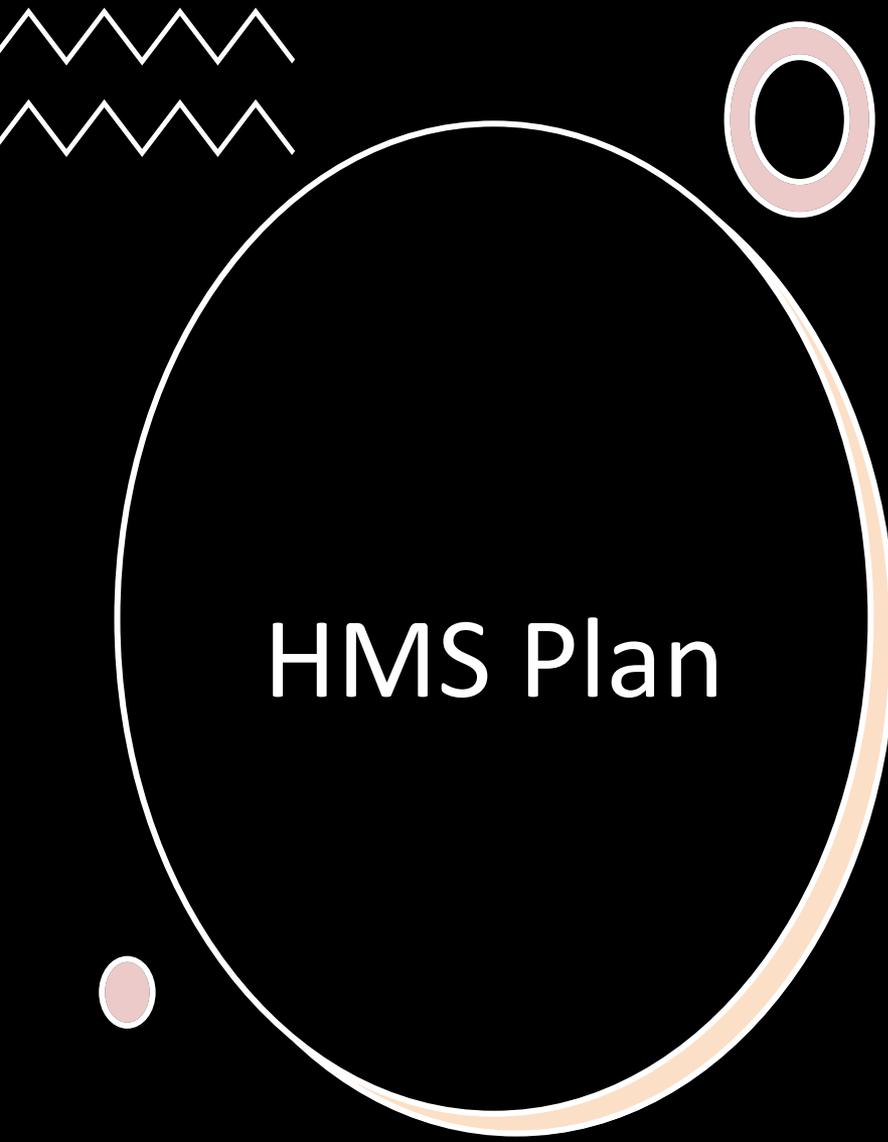


Northside Plan

Primary Focus:

- Essential Action 5.3 – Data-Driven Instruction within MTSS
- In general, Northside is implementing:
- A structured CFA (Common Formative Assessment) calendar
- Weekly PLC data meetings with a clear protocol
- A campus-wide Tier 2 intervention system
- Use of an MTSS intervention tracker and progress monitoring tools
- Small-group targeted instruction aligned to priority TEKS
- Leadership monitoring of intervention fidelity
- Coaching and feedback cycles for teachers
- Capacity building so the campus can sustain systems independently





HMS Plan

Primary Focus:

- Essential Action 5.3 – Evidence Collection and Analysis (CFA & PLC Process)
- In general, HMS is implementing:
- A consistent CFA creation and administration process
- Use of the Formative platform for assessment tracking
- Structured PLC agendas for analyzing student data
- Student grouping based on specific content gaps
- Planned “response instruction” days tied to CFA results
- Development of teacher-led PLC facilitation
- Leadership walkthroughs and feedback cycles
- Gradual release from administrator-led PLCs to teacher-led systems
