

## Attendance

9-12<sup>th</sup> grades average daily attendance (ADA) experienced a slight drop in Q3 but has maintained an average of 88.10% throughout the school year (SY) thus far. ADA for COSSA JR High has dropped in Q3. The average for 2023-24 SY is 81.75%.

ADA for the US in the 2023-24 SY is around 90%. While COSSA's numbers are slightly below this average, we believe chronic absenteeism for this demographic is a serious challenge and, as an attendance team, we continue to do the following:

- Meet daily and discuss missing students
- Flag students with 3 or more absences
- Make phone calls to parents/guardians with 3 or below
- Conduct home visits with students with 3-4 absences
- Set parent/guardian meetings with at-risk students

## Restorative Practices

Last board report, we reported that our sub-committees (student growth, restorative practices, and attendance) had met during February 2024 professional development and made recommendations for improved student recognition, professional

development for social/emotional learning, and student training modules for disciplinary purposes.

We had an issue on the CTE side with racial slurs and developed a blended learning module to address that issue. This, of course, can now be used for the Academy as we continue to expand our online modules to address discipline with both consequences and reintegration/restorative training.
