STUDENT CONDUCT: WEAPONS

FNCG (LOCAL)

The prohibition on student possession of weapons at school or any school-related activity [see FNCG preceding] extends to the following items, also considered to be weapons:

Knives of any size, including pocket knives

Fireworks of any kind

Razors

Chains

Any other object used in a way that threatens or inflicts bodily injury to another person

The possession or use of articles not generally considered to be weapons, including school supplies, may be prohibited when the principal or designee determines that a danger exists for any student, school employee, or school property by virtue of possession or use of such articles.

Cars parked on school premises, and lockers may be inspected by school personnel if there is reasonable cause to believe that they contain weapons. [See FNF(LEGAL) and (LOCAL)]

VIOLATIONS

Students found to be in violation of this policy shall be subject to disciplinary action as specified in the Student Code of Conduct.
