Purpose of Report

This report shows the attendance percentages for each grade level for the first grading cycle (September 30, 2013 – November 01, 2013).

Objectives

• District-wide totals are based on the number of students in each grade level.

- Attendance figures are taken from the PEIMS report.
- Attendance figures are based on 24 days (September 30 November 01).

Operational Impact

The attendance figures from PEIMS are used to determine the district ADA.

<u>Results</u>

- The total attendance average for the Denton ISD for Cycle 2 is 96.54%.
- The lowest total attendance averages are for 12th graders at 94.16% followed by PK at 95.59%.
- The highest attendance averages are in the 6th grade at 97.41% followed by 4rd grade at 97.33%.
- Comparison: 2012's second grading cycle was 96.52%.
