STUDENTS STUDENT SMOKING

~~JUNE 20, 1988~~

The Board of Education has determined that a nonsmoking policy is necessary in order to:

Discourage smoking and other use of tobacco by students and to protect the health of others who may be affected by secondary smoking;

Enhance and promote a school district curriculum designed to enlighten students on the health hazard of smoking and others use of tobacco **or e-cigarettes**;

Respond to the enforceability problems of smoking and other use of tobacco **or e-cigarettes** by students under legal age; and

Respond to the nationwide health hazard and the attending problems created by smoking and other use of tobacco **or e-cigarettes**.

Therefore, the Board of Education has established that no Livonia Public School student shall smoke, chew, or otherwise use tobacco **or e-cigarettes** on school property nor shall any student, while on school property, have in his/her possession or under his/her control, tobacco in any form, **including e-cigarettes**.

The rule against the use and possession of tobacco **and e-cigarettes** shall be included as a "prohibited act" under the school district's "Procedures Governing Violation of School Rules," and the penalty for violation of this rule shall range from suspension to expulsion.
