RE: Sinking Fund Projects Contract Award Recommendation for 2017 Pavement Replacement Projects Churchill HS / Holmes MS / Buchanan ES

Dear Mr. Francis:

This letter transmits an update from Plante Moran Cresa (PMC) as it relates to the assignment to assist and advise Livonia Public Schools (LPS) in its selection of Prime Contractors for the Projects listed above. This update represents the mutual efforts of PMC, NTH Consultants, LPS administration and staff (the Team) to present a framework in order to identify, evaluate and recommend Prime Contractor firms for these Projects.

In March 2017, Construction Documents were formally issued and made available. An advertisement for bids was published in a local newspaper and also posted to the required State of Michigan websites.

On April 6, 2017, bid proposals were received for the Project, and over the next day were reviewed to determine budget implications. Interviews were conducted on April 7th and were attended by representatives from NTH Consultants, and LPS. The scope of work, project schedule, manpower requirements, and other particulars regarding the work were reviewed and discussed.

Upon completion of the interviews, and after subsequent clarifications and discussions, the Team is recommending Macomb Pipeline and Utilities for contract award at Holmes Middle School. Including hard construction at \$324,815.00 and construction contingency at \$40,000.00, the total Project award recommendation equals \$364,815.00.

For the Projects at Buchanan and Churchill the two bids received were incomplete and these projects will be re-bid at a later date.

For the Prime Contractor, the costs for this work will be detailed in AIA Contract A105 – 2007 Standard Form of Agreement between Owner and Contractor, pending final review and approval of terms by district legal counsel.

Per our discussion and review of the Contractor's bids received, we have reviewed the Contractors' bid totals for the referenced project. Based on our review the bids; specifically, the total bid to complete the work and the proposed contractor schedules and we recommend Livonia Public Schools retain Macomb Pipeline and Utilities for the 2017 Holmes Water Main Project. According Macomb's quote, the total construction contract amount should be \$324,815.00, not including bonds. However, we recommend maintaining some contingency funds for the project on the order of 10 to 15 percent (\$40,000) for unforeseen conditions that may be encountered.
