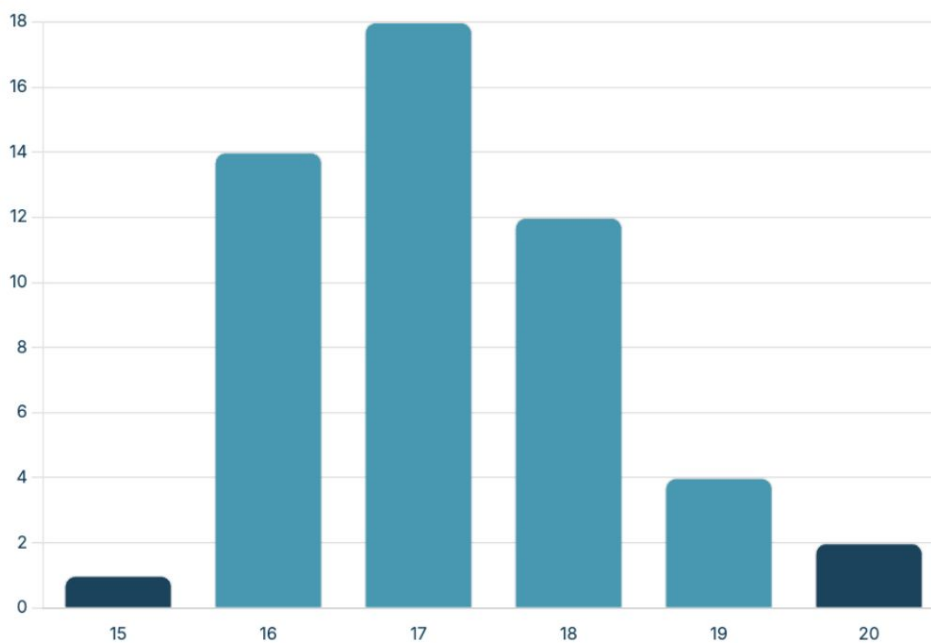
Who We Serve: A Demographic Snapshot

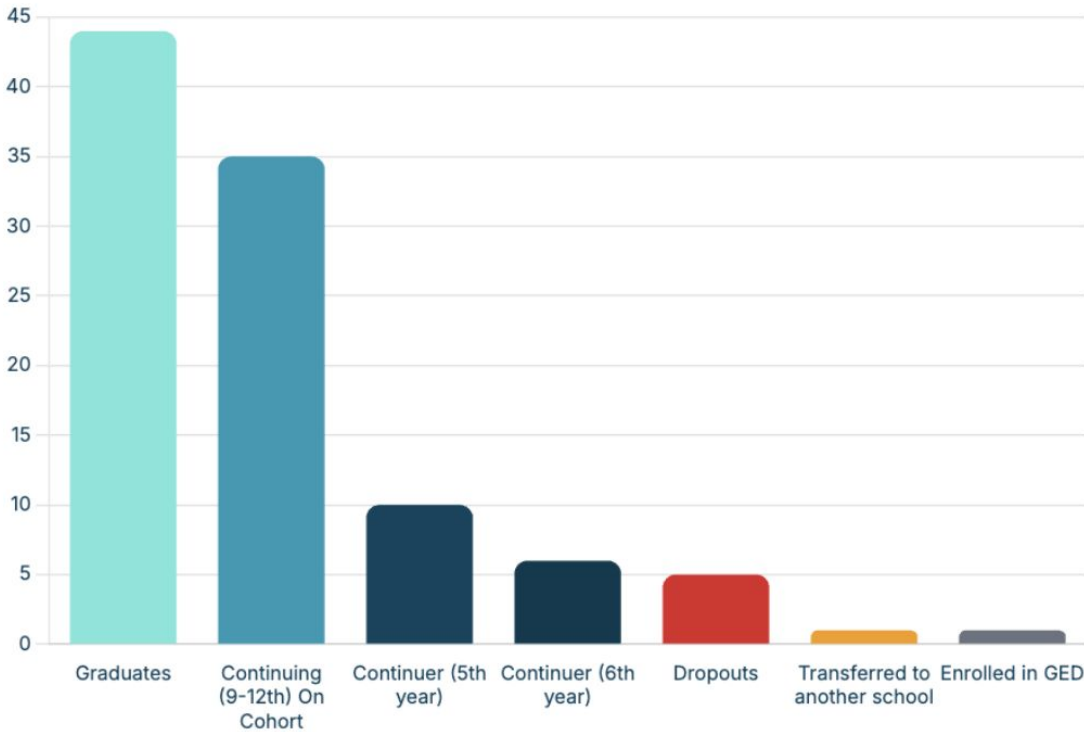
Our ultimate measure of success is student progress. The data shows a powerful story of achievement and persistence, with a significant number of students graduating and the majority continuing their path to a diploma.
