## TRANSPORTATION MANAGEMENT STUDENT TRANSPORTATION

CNA (LOCAL)

Eligibility Hazardous
Traffic Conditions
and High-Risk Areas

If the District applies for the additional transportation allotment provided by the state for students who live within two miles of a school campus, the Board shall adopt a resolution to identify hazardous traffic conditions or areas presenting a high risk of violence within two miles of the school campus. The resolution shall include the specific hazardous or highrisk areas in which transportation shall be provided, and the District shall publish the locations of these routes. The Board shall adopt a revised resolution when necessary to accurately reflect changes to the conditions or areas.

The District shall provide transportation for any student who meets the eligibility requirements established under Education Code 25.155. An exception to the eligibility requirements may be made by the Superintendent or designee when transportation is requested for a documented medical/hardship condition.

Any student who voluntarily transfers from his or her assigned school campus to a school campus located in another attendance zone and who does not otherwise qualify under the provisions of the Education Code shall not be eligible for District transportation.

Applicable fees, if any, shall be approved by the Board and published in administrative regulations.
