

## Each week of Summer School will have a different PBL theme

Summer school consists of a 3 week session during session 1 and a 3 week session during session 2. Last summer the themes were the following: SEL Activities, BNAS, Space Explorers, Culinary, Survival/Rez Explorations, Engineering and Inventions, and Book Worms. The BNAS week was in conjunction with the district BNAS Language workshop. The week themes also take into account a subject area: ELA, math, science, social studies, and BNAS in hands on, interactive learning. *Early Kindergarten students currently enrolled in BPS for the 22-23 school year will be eligible for the K-2 cohort.*

## Summer School

BPS Summer School is an academic based program for grades K-12 that will be using Project Based Learning (PBL) as the main resource for instruction. PBL will help your student improve on writing, inquiry, collaboration, organization, & reading in a hands on, interactive, fun learning environment. The cohorts will include: K-2nd grade, 3rd grade-5th grade, 6th grade-8th grade and high school. Session 1 of summer school will begin June 12th and end on June 29th. Session 2 will begin on July 10th and end on July 27th. Each session will run Mon-Thur each week. Each instructional day will begin at 9am and end at 2pm. Each week will have a guiding theme to allow the teacher & student to experience a wide variety of educational opportunities. Registration will begin April 19th at each school building & administration building.

## Teachers

*Each week will have a final project*

Teachers will have up to 28 hours per week to work. Each day begins at 8am and ends at 3pm for 7 hours of work with a working lunch. It is mandatory that each teacher be in attendance from 9am-2pm daily for the instructional portion of the day. The first and last hours of each day are for planning purposes. There will be a K-8 coordinator who will help guide the facilitation of the daily schedule & be responsible for the completion of the all supporting paperwork. Each teacher will equally & equitably participate in all planning of the lessons & in the performance of that plan. The K-8 coordinator is not responsible for administrative duties of the staff, the role will be similar to an instructional coach with the Assistant Superintendent providing the administrative support to ensure that all expectations are being met and that each staff member is provided the help and support that is needed. The K-8 coordinator will also take the lead on any behavior management. Teachers will clock in & out everyday via their usual method to document their hours worked. There will be 16 hours of planning that will take place beginning at the end of April that will be whole group, small group & individual to plan & prep for both sessions. This schedule will provided asap.

**Summer School sessions 1 & Session 2 for K-8 will be located at BES. Session 1 & Session 2 for high school students will be located at BHS. There will be K-2 cohort; 3-5 cohort; 6-8 cohorts at BES. Breakfast & lunch will be provided on a daily basis beginning at 8:15am for breakfast & 11:30am for lunch. Bus transportation will be provided on a daily basis as well for all students if needed & requested.**



#### Secretaries

Each location will be provided a secretary to help with communication & support for students & staff. This secretary will also be responsible for all daily secretary duties.

#### K-12 Counselor

There will be a K-12 counselor who will be responsible for providing support for all summer school students. Primary responsibility will be high school registration.

#### K-8 Coordinator

There will be a K-8 coordinator who will support the Assistant Superintendent in daily support & monitoring of the K-8 summer school cohorts.

#### High School

PBL summer school will focus primarily on social studies; Credit recovery will focus on English, math, science; HPE/Wellness will provide health, PE, & elective



### Teacher Assistants

TA's will be expected to conduct their normal duties and be guided by the specific daily schedule for that cohort. Each TA has the same total hours as Teachers with mandatory attendance being 8am-2:30pm with breaks & lunch as scheduled throughout the day. TA's primary focus will be student supervision as assigned from 8am-9am and 2pm-2:30pm daily to welcome students into the buildings, monitor students, & ensure their safe travel home or transition to Eegahkimaht. TA's will also have a duty free lunch & break time opposite the teachers lunch & plan time to ensure students are always monitored.



### BPS Summer School Goals

The goal of the BPS Summer School is to provide all students & staff with a fun & engaging learning experience. Students will have the opportunity to be engaged in holistic learning that is designed by the teachers using the PBL framework to provide whole child support.
